### **PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE**

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
On Saturday, April 29, 2006 from 1800h-2400h our Laboratory Information System servers will be relocated to an environmentally controlled, off-site location. This relocation will enhance the security of our data and the quality of service for all our clients.

Between 1800h and 2400h on April 29, 2006 the laboratory will be in manual production mode, and hard copy, faxed, and electronic reports will be unavailable to clients. Laboratory technical staff will continue to phone critical results as per standard operating procedure. It is imperative that you document your contact information (phone and fax numbers) on the requisitions you submit to ensure effective communication of these results.

Regular reporting, including the distribution of reports backlogged during the server relocation will resume once the relocation is complete.

**Please note that this notice applies to reports generated by both ProvLab and the Medical Microbiology Laboratory at the University of Alberta Hospital.** It does **NOT** apply to reports generated by the Department of Laboratory Medicine and Pathology at the University of Alberta Hospital.

We anticipate the relocation of these servers will be a seamless transition for our clients. We sincerely thank you for your patience and consideration during this temporary disruption to our information systems.



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
